Eye Test FAQ's

If I'm over 60, am I entitled to a FREE eye test at home?

Yes, if you cannot get to a high street opticians unaccompanied, visit our website for more details - www.outsideclinic.com/ServicesFree.html

How long will the visit last?

Typically the optician will be with you for up to an hour to examine your eyes and discuss your optical requirements.

Will I be able to choose spectacles?

Yes, a comprehensive range of spectacle frames are available from our opticians to suit all pockets, ranging from free (to those who qualify on income eligibility) to designer names. There is also a range of over 500 lenses to choose from, to accommodate all types of prescriptions.

What do I need to sign for my NHS test, and does the optician need to see proof?

Yes, you will be required to sign a GOS (General Ophthalmic Services) application form for the test to be conducted. Proof of eligibility will be requested by your optician, as required under current regulations. Your signature is also confirmation of your entitlement, should proof not be available.

Hearing Test FAQ's

I am entitled to a FREE hearing test, am I entitled to a FREE hearing aid?

Whilst we offer a free hearing test our hearing aid dispensing service is private. If you wish to have NHS hearing aids you must go through your GP.

How long will the visit last?

The Hearing Aid Audiologist can be with you for up to an hour and a half, depending on your requirements.

Will I be able to choose hearing aids?

Yes. After an audiogram has been taken, the Hearing Aid Audiologist can help you choose hearing aids to help suit your hearing loss, lifestyle, dexterity and budget.

What if the hearing aid audiologist finds wax in my ear?

If the Hearing Aid Audiologist finds your ears to be either partially or wholly obstructed with wax then they will refer you to have it removed. If you believe that the presence of wax may be contributing to your hearing loss, speak to your audiologist about wax removal or a referral to your GP.

Your Entitlement - Sight Test

You are entitled to a FREE NHS sight test at home if you can no longer get to a high street optician unaccompanied and fall into one of the categories below.

Aged 60 and over

Under 16, or under 19 and in full time education

Registered blind or partially sighted

Diagnosed as having Diabetes or Glaucoma

Aged 40 or over with a direct relative with Glaucoma, or have been

advised by an ophthalmologist that you are at risk of Glaucoma

Prescribed a complex lens

If you receive the following benefits or credits:

Income Support or Income Based Job Seekers Allowance (not contribution based)

Pension Credit Guarantee Credit (Not Savings Credit)

Income-based Employment and Support Allowance (not contribution-based)

Child Tax Credit and are named on a Tax Credit NHS

Exemption Certificate

You are named on a NHS certificate for full help with health costs
