Learning Disability Partnership Needs Representatives



Siblings Matter

Family Fund have launched a new report, published jointly with University of Portsmouth, called 'Do Siblings Matter Too?' The report reveals the impact a disabled brother or sister has on a child or young person and highlights a number of key themes for siblings, ranging from elements of a typical sibling relationship to issues of lack of time, experience of aggression, violence and emotional upset.

Data taken from over 2,000 Family Fund assessments contributed to the report, in which the key findings show:

- Siblings are often overlooked and their needs often ignored by policy makers and service providers.
- · Siblings are not identified by local authorities and schools.
- Families need access to short breaks in order to be able to support their other children.
- Few siblings are being supported by agencies such as Child and Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) or Young Carer groups, and it would be of benefit if access to these and similar services could be made more widely available.
